

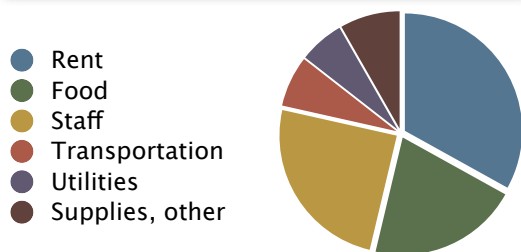

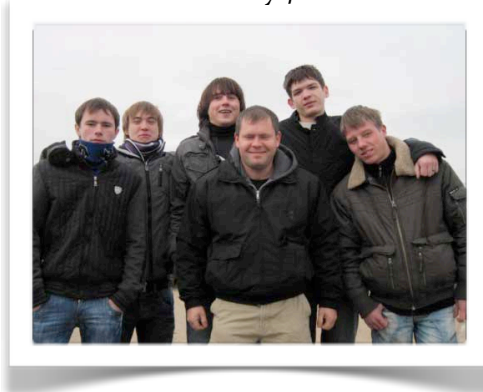

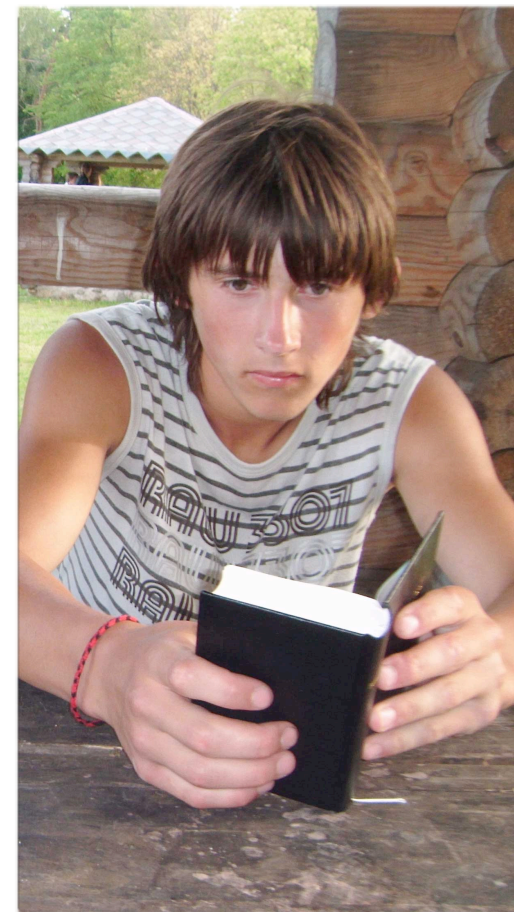

### What and Why

Belarus is a poor republic that suffered much in its history before gaining independence in 1991, and the suffering continues.

Consequently this has led to the breakdown of leadership in families and a lack of men who will take responsibility for the future of the country. Many men are alcoholics and most don't attend church. Lives are ruined and lost in hopelessness.

Most orphaned young men fare worse. They return to their town of birth, find menial work and enter a cycle of defeat.

Our vision is for a home where orphaned young men can live and continue their education. There they will be encouraged to grow in faith, take part in mercy ministries, and experience a model for family living.

The directors of Spring of Revival in Minsk and the board of Stoneworks International would like to start a men's home in the fall of 2011.



### Helping Men Become a Blessing

Praise God, a few young men are choosing a better way.

Because of our years of service in orphanages, we know young men who are ready to participate. Two thirds of orphans in Belarus are boys, so there are many more to follow.

Timothy House will provide an opportunity for them to begin changing their way of thinking and become messengers of Hope.

They will take part in Bible studies and ministry opportunities, such as chopping wood for foster families, helping with repairs and building projects, assisting in gardening and other acts of service.

Investing in these young men has benefits lasting into eternity as they become effective communicators of Christ's love and mercy in Belarus.

A commitment to Christ.

Willingness to follow guidelines of the home, including church attendance and involvement in ministries.

Recent graduation from an orphanage, shelter or foster home in Belarus.

Desire to complete a vocational school or university education.
